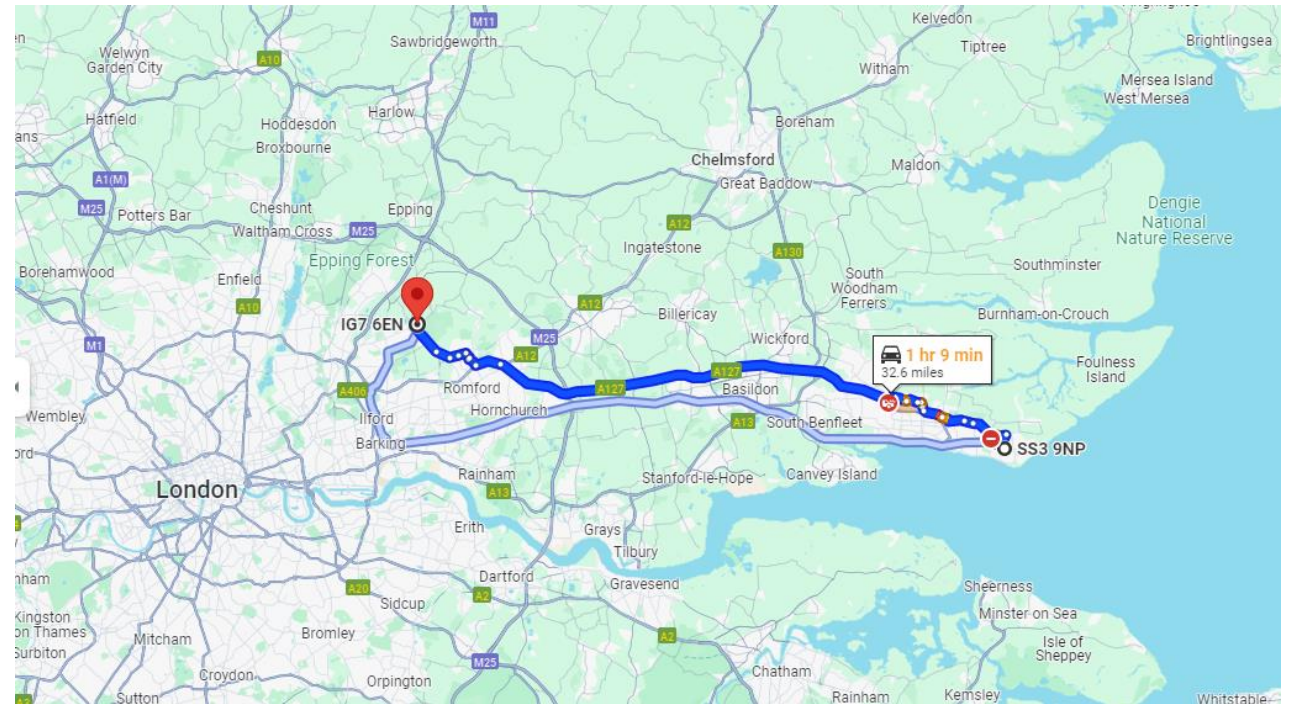

Chigwell Row Campsite

Accommodation

- Children will be staying in lodges
- Each accommodates up to 25 people
- Most rooms have bunk beds



Food

- Pupils need to have their own packed lunch for the day of departure (24th)
- School will prepare lunch for pupils in receipt of FSM (a slip for this will go out nearer the time)
- After this, all meals are included in the price and will be cooked on site.

vegetarian alternative available for each meal where necessary. **(will need to know if any children have special requirements)**

Drinks will be available throughout the day. Although we advise to bring a water bottle to refill

Daily snacks mid morning and mid afternoon.

All children will need to bring a sturdy water bottle.

Pricing

- The price for the residential is approx £120-140 (based on 35 pupils going)
- A non-refundable deposit of **£50** is required to secure the place by 31st January (payments open at 9am Monday 15th December)
- The office can support with setting up a payment plan
- All payments will be paid via the app

Other information

- Pupil to adult ratio of 1:10 (in line with guidelines), including qualified first aiders
- Kit lists will be provided nearer the time – pupils will need their own sleeping bag and pillow
- Detailed timings and activities will be sent out closer to the residential, once we have final confirmation from the venue
- No electrical devices are permitted, including phones and ipads. This is a non-negotiable expectation due to safeguarding
- Any medications need to be given to us on the day of the residential in a clear, labelled container/ bag with administration instructions

Other information

- This trip is behaviour dependent. We need to ensure that the children attending can be sensible, follow instructions and remain safe. Unfamiliar adults will be leading the activities and therefore we need to be certain that the children involved can be respectful and safe.
- If you have any concerns or questions around this area, please speak to the class teacher in the first instance.
